Securely match children and families to the right services



Send referrals to a wide variety of partners, including immigration organizations, food pantries, or department of social services.



Intake

Maria is a head start educator who learns a child and his family are experiencing food insecurity at home so she takes action.



Referral

Maria uses NCCARE360 to send electronic referrals to community partners in real time to address the family's need for food and other social supports.



Resolution

Community organizations accept the referrals for services and provide the family with resources and support.



Feedback

As the family receives resources and services, Maria receives realtime updates and tracks the family's total whole-care journey.
