Securely match individuals to the right services



Send referrals to a wide variety of partners, including immigration organizations, food pantries, or department of social services.



Intake

Maria is a primary care physician who learns her patient is experiencing food insecurity and takes action.



Referral

Maria uses NCCARE360 to send electronic referrals to community partners in real time to address her patient's need for food and other social supports.



Resolution

Community organizations accept the referrals for services and provide the patient with resources and support.



Feedback

As her patient receives resources and services, Maria receives real-time updates and tracks her patient's total whole-care journey.
